2012-2013 Scholarship Application

Funded by an endowment created by the former Jackson County YMCA, this scholarship is awarded annually to a student enrolled in the College of Education, who graduated from a high school within Jackson County.

CRITERIA for the JACKSON COUNTY FAMILY YMCA SCHOLARSHIP

- complete and return attached application
- submit two (2) letters of recommendation
- submit a current/official SIUC transcript
- must be currently enrolled in a departmental program within the College of Education
- be a registered, full-time student at SIUC
- must be a graduate of a high school within Jackson County, Illinois.

One scholarship will be awarded for the 2012-2013 academic year, totaling \$2,000. The award will be credited to the recipient's SIUC Bursar account, in the amount of \$1,000 each for fall and spring semesters. Failure to be enrolled for the entire academic semester, either fall or spring, will result in the revocation of the scholarship award. All applications will be reviewed by the Jackson County Chapter Scholarship Committee.

All application materials must be submitted (not postmarked or faxed) to the SIU Alumni Association office prior to 4:30 p.m., Friday, March 2, 2012. Each applicant will be notified by mail of his/her application status. The recipient will be invited and recognized at the annual Jackson County Awards Banquet held in November. The recipient is expected to attend the Banquet.
